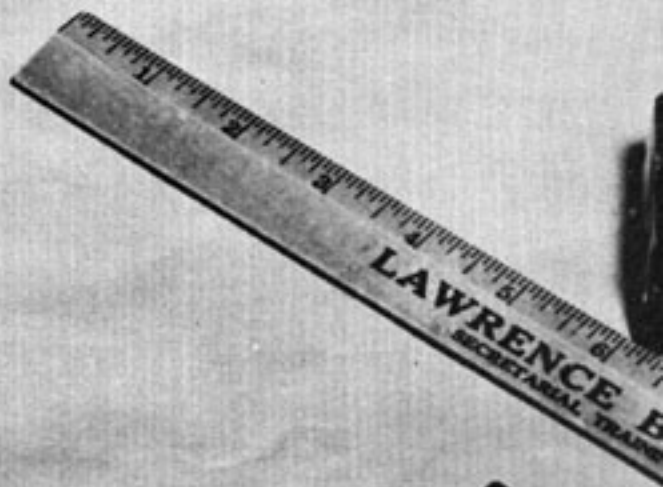
Dear Carol:
