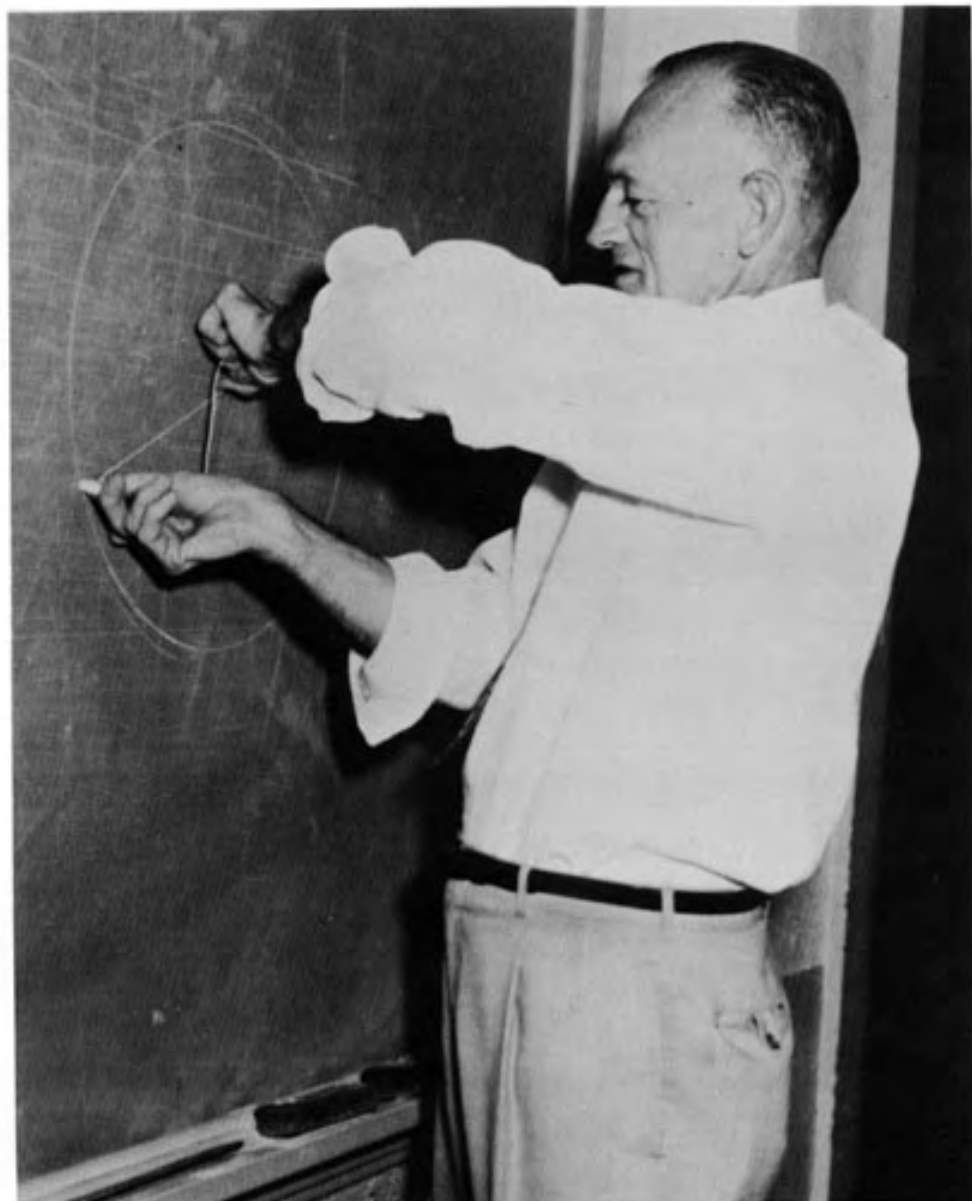

Principal Shaw Explains Keysort System

The new system of grade cards which is being used this year is known as the "Keysort System." Each card is actually a set of seven parts, one which will be given to the student at the end of each six weeks' grading period, and final part which remains for school use. Around the edge of the set it is possible to groove information which is needed from time to time in the office. A different colored sheet of the set is used for each

grading period. After the top sheets are issued to the students, the rest of the sets are returned to the office. Here by the Keysort method they can be quickly sorted alphabetically to bring all grade cards of an individual student together. It is possible to sort the sets in many other ways also because of the information grooved around the edge. After the grades are recorded on the students' permanent record sheets at the end of the year, the final part of the
